Greene Metropolitan Housing Authority (GMHA) will close the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HVC) wait list effective May 1, 2008, except for families and individuals who are homeless according to HUD's definition – staying in a shelter (emergency or transitional) or living on the street or in a place not meant for human habitation. Those staying in transitional housing must have been homeless prior to admittance in the program. The Public Housing, Yellow Springs Village Greene and Shelter Plus Care wait lists will remain open.

Homeless individual and families will need to turn in a form to document homelessness at the time the application is submitted or the application will not be accepted. Homeless individuals and families will need to have a GMHA form to document homelessness signed by the emergency or transitional shelter where they are staying.

Homeless individuals and families will need to view the Application video in order to apply for housing assistance. The video will be shown on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. The video will no longer be shown on the first and third Saturdays of the month.

When GMHA is ready to open the Section 8 HCV wait list, a notice will be in the county paper, social service agencies will be notified, notification will be provided to all agencies working with families and individuals with disabilities, and a notice will be on GMHA's website.
